You should be wearing your black logo shirt, black sliders, black athletic shorts/pants, black socks, and black marching shoes.
- 10:15 am Visual Rehearsal
- 11:15 am Boosters will serve a snack.
- 11:30 am Change into uniforms
For changing purposes, females need to wear a white cami underneath their logo shirt.
- 12:00 pm Load buses - **Make sure you have all items listed on the Packing List.**
- 12:15 pm Depart for the Dome at America's Center
- 1:10 pm Arrive to the Dome at America's Center; unload and assemble instruments
- 1:50 pm Move to Official Warm-Up Area (Silent Troop)
- 2:10 pm **PHYSICAL WARM-UP – FOCUS!**
- 2:30 pm **MUSIC WARM-UP – FOCUS!**
- 2:50 pm Front Ensemble Report to Staging Area
- 3:15 pm **FIELD SHOW PERFORMANCE!**
- 3:30 pm Pictures by Jolesch Photography
- 3:45 pm Return to buses; load instruments, shakos, and plumes.

- 4:15 pm Head into the dome and watch bands.
(Once we are inside, no one is allowed to leave the dome until we depart as a group.)
- 5:45 pm Head back to buses
- 6:15 pm Depart for Timberland
- 7:15 pm Arrive to school. Unload buses and trucks and change out of uniforms.

Travel Guidelines

1. Loud, noisy, rude, or immoral behavior and public use of profanity will not be tolerated.
2. In keeping with the expectations of the Timberland Band Program, Public Display of Affection is limited to hand holding only. Those in violation will be paired with a director and/or parent chaperone for the remainder of the day.
3. In accordance with the Wentzville R-IV School District Policy, no food is allowed to be consumed on the buses. Bottled water will be available during transportation. Students are able to bring food to consume when off of district transportation.
4. All changing of clothes/uniforms will be done on separate buses. Don't spray cologne, perfume, or body sprays on the buses.
5. No football/catch items will be allowed.
6. No radios, CD players, MP3 players, etc. will be played without the use of headphones. If DVD players are brought (not recommended), headphones must be used and any movies may only be G or PG. (These must stay on the bus.) The directors also have the right to have you discontinue use of electronic devices.
7. No standing or sitting on the back of bus seats. No one gets off the bus until it is cleaned and you are dismissed. Emergency door is for loading and unloading equipment, not bodies.
8. Ride the same bus to and from the festival. Only members and staff of the THS Band and parent chaperones are allowed to ride the bus to and from performances.
9. Treat the band booster parents with the utmost respect. They help make this trip and others like it possible. If you get the chance, a kind word of "thanks" is appreciated
10. You are representing your school and community at this event. All school rules are in effect. Please conduct yourself in a professional manner. Always present ourselves with CLASS.
