


## Recording Options and Instructions

1. Record right into Canvas. Just click on Start Assignment then choose the media tab. You will get an option to record.

3. Use the app [Soundcorset](#). It is a free app available for Apple or Android. You will need to use the Google Drive app to upload it then submit on Canvas using the Google Drive option..
4. Or use any other means that can record in the following files formats: mp3, wav, aac, aiff, m4a, mov, mp4
